Prep Curriculum



English

Prep students engage in 2 hours of literacy lessons each day, covering Reading and Viewing, Writing and Speaking and Listening. We have a strong focus on fostering confidence and enjoyment in English skills, to build a solid foundation for the years ahead.





Mathematics

Prep Students engage in daily Maths lessons and use a variety of hands on experiences to develop their numeracy skills. We support students to demonstrate their understandings and problem solve tasks using their mathematical knowledge.



Inquiry Learning

Science, Digital/Design Technology, Humanities and Health are all taught through inquiry topics each term. These studies promote students personal and social capabilities whilst learning about the world around us.





BWPS Specialist Classes







Students attend weekly sessions in our dedicated art room. Prep students use different materials and techniques to create art that expresses their ideas, observations & imagination.

ITALIAN

Learning a language begins in Prep and continues right throughout primary school. Prep students begin by learning the colours, numbers and greetings.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

Prep students learn fundamental movement skills. They focus on learning basic rules and working together cooperatively to enjoy PE.

PERFORMING ARTS

Prep music focuses on making beats, responding to rhythms, singing and playing instruments. We run a whole school production every 2nd year.

WELLBEING

At BWPS we learn to build healthy relationships, resilience and confidence. We aim to flourish by 'feeling good and doing good'. We promote Positive Education.

Buddies

Grade 6 students work with the Preps in our Buddies program across the whole year, to support their transition to school. Together they complete activities in all curriculum areas.

Kitchen Garden

Students work hands on in the garden to plant and grow fresh produce. They then use this produce in cooking classes to make delicious meals.

Dance/Choir/Bands

These programs aim to let students express themselves through various art forms. We hold concerts for the students to showcase what they have learnt.
